**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
THE SERBIAN UNITY CONGRESS**

I.

The name of the Corporation shall be the Serbian Unity Congress.

II.

The Corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized and to be operated under the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C.) as now enacted or as may hereafter be amended or succeeded by a new provision. In carrying out its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall possess and may exercise all powers provided or allowed by the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act as now enacted or as may hereafter be amended or succeeded by a new provision.

III.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. The private property of the members, directors and officers of the Corporation shall not be liable for the payment of corporate debts.

IV.

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

V.

The Corporation shall have such members, classes of members or no members as provided in the Bylaws.

VI.

The general management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be under the control, supervision, and direction of the Board of Directors and such other officers and committees as may be provided for in the Bylaws or appointed by the Board of Directors pursuant to the Bylaws. The first Board of Directors shall consist of the fourteen directors whose names and addresses are as follows:

IX.

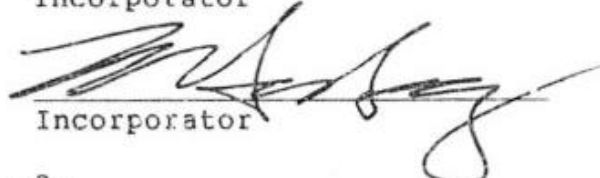
In the event of the dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation, or if for any reason the Corporation shall become defunct or no longer be in existence, all assets remaining after all liabilities and obligations of the Corporation have been paid, satisfied, discharged, or adequate provision has been made therefor, shall be distributed to one or more organizations organized and operated for purposes within the purview of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C.), as now enacted or as may hereafter be amended or succeeded by a new provision, and which have exemption from federal income tax under such section, or to the federal, state or local government for a public purpose.

No amendment to these Articles of Incorporation shall be made unless such amendment is adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors upon receiving the vote of a majority of the directors in office.

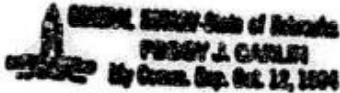
